



Savings Tips

Have students draw pictures of their savings goals and tape them to their piggy banks, savings jars, or paper banks.

A drawing of a toy or a trip to a theme park will help students visualize what they are saving for and encourage them to save. As an added incentive, parents may match the savings amount.

Have students keep a record of how much is in their savings bank:

- Count out the money already there.
- Record that amount.
- Record each additional amount and add the deposits (students may need some help with the math).
